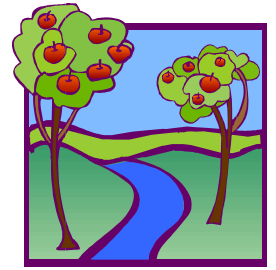


But his delight is in the law of the Lord,

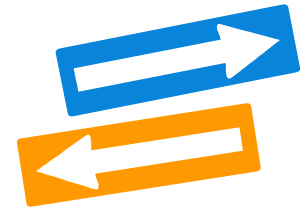
