<p>Bible Story: The Fall of Man Genesis 1:27 and Genesis 3</p> <p>Bible Memory: Psalm 119:11 They Word have I hid in my heart that I might not sin against Thee.</p>	1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Prayer • Bible Story: Introduce and read the Bible Story • Bible Memory • Songs and Movement: 'Standing in the Need of Prayer' 'God Made My Face' • Nursery Rhyme: Introduce, read/chant, and discuss 'Little Jack Horner'. • Phonemic Awareness: Listen to two words spoken orally. Are they the same or different? (<i>Exp. plum /thumb</i>) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Story: <u>Bear Obeys</u> by Mary Manz Simon Focus on how God made us and loves us. Go through the 'Rules' cards and discuss how each one is to keep us safe. Discuss what God's rule was for Adam and Eve. • Sing/Chant/Move to ABC's • Letter Recognition Focus Introduce Letter 'Aa' using the Picture Review Sheet and the letter 'Aa Song', relate to Bible Story • Environmental Print: Place a piece of environmental print on the "I Can Read" board. (<i>Exp. Apple Jacks or Arby's</i>) Ask your child 'Can you read this?' Then let your child hunt for other print to add to the I Can Read board that starts with that same letter. Print can be added at any time during the week! • Letter Art: Make Thumbprint apples on the Letter Aa outline. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Review Game or Flashcards for colors, shapes, numerals, name, birthday, phone number, and address • Calendar/Oral Counting with Movement (Same daily.) • Math Happy Apple 1) Make cards with multiples for each numeral (0-9 + an apple). 2) Make matches until only the apple is left and the person holding the apple, wins • Math Art: Open an apple and count the seeds. Make apple prints. Glue the seeds. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Make homemade applesauce! • (<i>Either use real baskets and fake/real apples or use clipart of baskets and apple stickers.</i>) Attach a numeral card to the different baskets. Have the child read the numeral and place that same number of apples or stickers in the basket.
	2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Prayer • Bible Story: Review Bible Story using <u>Devotions for Little Boys and Girls: Old Testament</u> by Joan Webb p. 14 • Bible Memory • Songs and Movement: 'Standing in the Need of Prayer' 'Be Careful Little Eyes' • Nursery Rhyme: Reread/chant, and discuss 'Little Jack Horner'. • Phonemic Awareness: Play 'Sound Bingo' using household sounds. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Story: <u>The Story of Adam and Eve</u> by Patricia Pingry What is sin? What are some consequences of sin? • Sing/Chant/Move to ABC's • Letter Recognition Focus Review Letter 'Aa' using the Picture Review Sheet and the letter 'Aa Song', relate to Bible Story. • Friend/Family Name Wall: Pray for each individual as their name is added. Stress that the first letter in a name is always uppercase. Hunt for the corresponding lowercase letter in other names also on display. Point to and read all of the names on the name wall so far. • Letter Sort: Sort Uppercase A's from lowercase a's onto two different colored apple cut outs. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Review Game or Flashcards for colors, shapes, numerals, name, birthday, phone number, address, and letters studied • Calendar/Oral Counting with Movement (Same daily.) • Math Numeral Jump 1) Draw numerals in large boxes on the sidewalk, make the boxes connect to form a rectangle, with a space for the child to stand in the middle –write the numerals in mixed up order 2) Call out a numeral and have the child jump to that numeral 3) Then have the child try to hop on the numerals in order (0-9) by hopping on a numeral and then hopping to the middle, hopping on the next numeral and hopping to the middle, etc. • Math Art 1) Play Apple Counting in which your child reads 	

				<p>the numeral on the tree, counts out that many red pom poms, matches the pom poms to the apples at the top for 1 to 1 correspondence, and then recounts the pom poms as they place them on the tree.</p> <p>2) Have your child use their fingerprints to make a tree. Write a numeral. Have your child add that many fingerprint apples to the tree!</p>	
3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Prayer • Bible Story: Review Bible Story using <u>Devotions for Little Boys and Girls: Old Testament</u> by Joan Webb p. 15 • Bible Memory • Songs and Movement: Review Songs; 'Way Up High' • Nursery Rhyme: Reread/chant, and discuss 'Little Jack Horner'. • Phonemic Awareness: Reread the nursery rhyme, pausing for your child to fill in or say the missing rhyming word. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Story: <u>How Do Apples Grow?</u> By Betsy Maestro or <u>I Am An Apple</u> by Jean Marzollo • Sing/Chant/Move to ABC's • Letter Recognition Focus Review Letter 'Aa' using the Picture Review Sheet and the letter 'Aa Song', relate to Bible Story • Tactile Formation: Use a finger to trace over the sandpaper letters A and a. Encourage the child to say 'Aa' says /a/ or to sing the letter 'Aa Song' as they trace. • Letter Sort: Sort Aa's from other letters that are not Aa's. • Name Practice: Play Name Bingo using a few family members' names and close friends' names. Use apple seeds, apple shaped erasers, or smiley face erasers as markers. Children can use the drawn card to locate the same name if needed. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Review Game or Flashcards for colors, shapes, numerals, name, birthday, phone number, address, and letters studied • Calendar/Oral Counting with Movement (Same daily.) • Science: <i>Focus: Fruit that grows on trees</i> Read 'Fruit'. Discuss and then show pictures of real fruit trees. Show a sampling of real fruit grown on trees such as apples, oranges, pears, cherries, coconuts, grapefruit, etc. Discuss the texture, smell, shape, color, and taste of each! • Science Art: Make scratch and sniff fruit pictures by painting fruit shapes with a mixture of 1-2 TBS water and Kool-Aid.
