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Scripture Memorization for Easter


Choose to memorize a passage of Scripture leading up to Easter Sunday!

Step 2: The Triumphal Entry



- Resurrection Eggs: Blue (donkey)
- Scripture Reading: Matthew 21:1-11

(John 12:12-15, Mark 11:1-11, Luke 19:28-44)

- Verse to Mediate: Zechariah 9:9
- Easter Basket Reminder: Palm branch
- Passion Hymn: All Glory, Laud, and Honor
- Activity / Craft:
 - -Make Palm Branches or Joyful Egg Shakers
 - -Reenact the Triumphal Entry. Let your kids wave their palm branches, lay coats on the floor, shout Hosanna ('Save us now.'), etc. This moment had been prophesied about in the Old Testament. The people expected an earthly king to save them from their troubles, but they were actually welcoming God's chosen spiritual Savior saving us from our sins!
- Scripture Memorization:

Philippians 2:5 OR Psalm 103:1-2

Ideas for constructing Palm Branches:







Above: Cut out a palm leaf shape. Add some texture and coloring with markers, chenile stems, sponge paint, etc.. Below: Sponge paint around the outside edge of a plam leaf. Lift to reveal a crisp outline. Add text to the middle.





Joyful Egg Shakers:

Place some rice, dried, beans, cereal, or uncooked pasta in a couple of plastic eggs. Let your little ones shake their egg instruments joyfully and sing praises to Jesus!


