JOY Ornaments



Choose 6-8 circles, making sure you have at least 1 JOY and 1 verse. Put them in order – varying the ones with text and patterns.





Fold each circle in half.



Place glue on the backside of one half of the first circle. Then, carefully line it up and attach it to the next half circle. Press firmly.





Continue adding circles in this manner, until you only have one circle left.





Gather your wire, 6 beads, and a prism.







String the prism to the center of the wire and then fold the wire in half.





String 3 beads over both ends of the folded wire.





Place the folded wire in the center of the ornament, lining up the beads to the bottom of the ornament.

Tape it securely.





Place glue on the backside of the last circle.



Carefully line up the edges and press firmly.







String 3 beads onto the remaining wire at the top of the ornament.





Tie the wire at the top to from a loop.

Place glue on two outer edges of the circles.



Carefully rock the wet edges of the ornament back and forth in the glitter. Continue with the other edges until all are coated.



Let dry completely.

JOY Scripture Ornaments

Materials needed:

- ✓ Scrapbook paper in coordinating colors and patterns.
- ✓ Wire 18 inches per ornament
- ✓ Pony beads 6 per ornament
- ✓ Prism bead 1 per ornament

Preparations:

- Print out the JOY and Scripture circles onto plain colored scrapbook paper.
- Cut around each circle.
- Cut the same size of circles from patterned scrapbook paper.
- Measure wire to be 18 inches long.
- Print step by step visual instructions.




