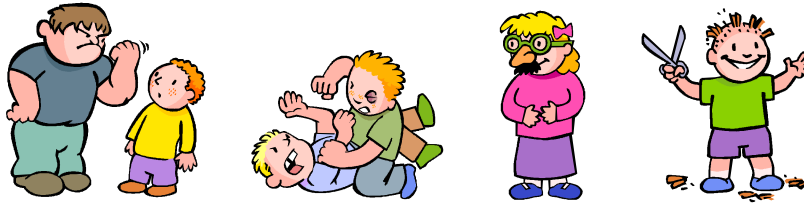
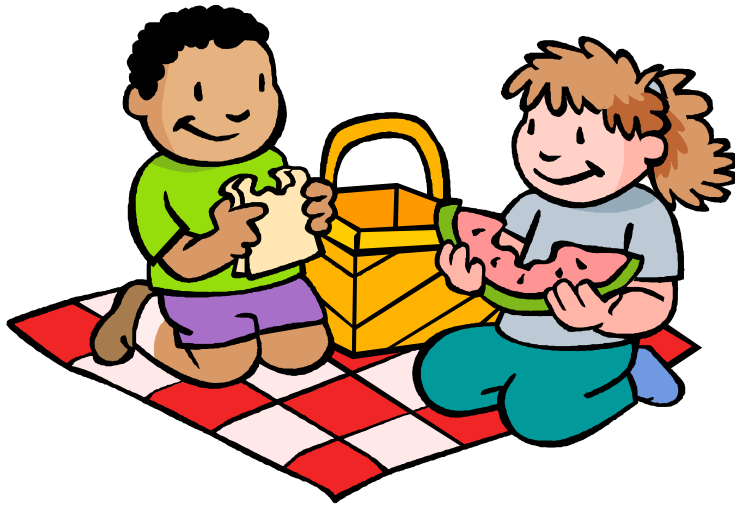

Accompanying Motions:

<i>Do not</i>	<i>Shake head 'No.'</i>
<i>misled</i>	<i>Hold your left hand palm down, with only your pinky and index finger extended. Repeat with the other hand. Slide your right hand next to and past the left hand.</i>
<i>bad</i>	<i>Bring your left hand to your mouth, touching your fingertips to your lips. Turn your head away as you bring your hand down and away from your mouth.</i>
<i>company</i>	<i>Link your two index fingers.</i>
<i>corrupts</i>	<i>Pretend to rip something apart (like tearing paper).</i>
<i>good</i>	<i>Move your right hand from your mouth to your other hand which is flat, palm side up. It is as if you have just tasted something that was good and now you want to share it with others.</i>
<i>character</i>	<i>With your left hand, form a 'C'. Holding this shape, rotate in a circular motion and then place the 'C' over your heart.</i>
