

Parkt of a Flower 'Grafficity'

Preparation

Print the word and definitions on regular copy paper. (page 4)

Print the parts of the flower (pages 5-7) on colored construction paper of your choice.

(If you prefer, you could use pages 8-9 to cut out tagboard tracers instead.)

Each child will also need the following....

- a 9 by 1 ½ inch strip of green construction paper to form the stem
- a small rectangle of brown construction paper to tear into strips for the roots
- 3. a 12 by 18 inch sheet of construction paper Fold in half lengthwise and pre cut the sections.

 (I cut the middle slit first, followed by cutting the bottom section 2 more times and the top section just one more time so as to form sections of 2/6 (for the flower petals at the top), 1/6 for sepals, 1/6 for the leaf, 1/6 for the stem label, and 1/6 for the roots.)



get water from the soil		



carries water to all parts of the plant


protect the flower as it is forming (when it is a bud) and support the petals when it is in bloom


