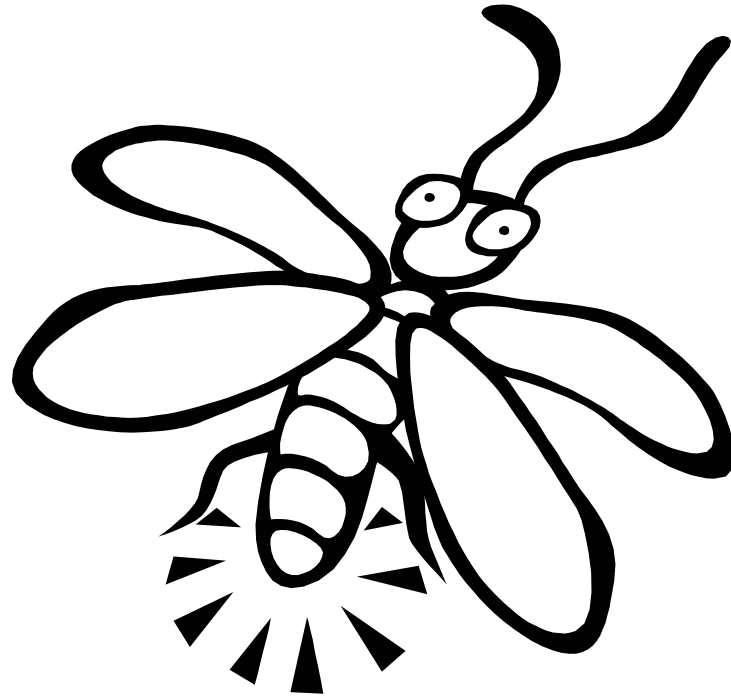
The owl will not sleep at night.



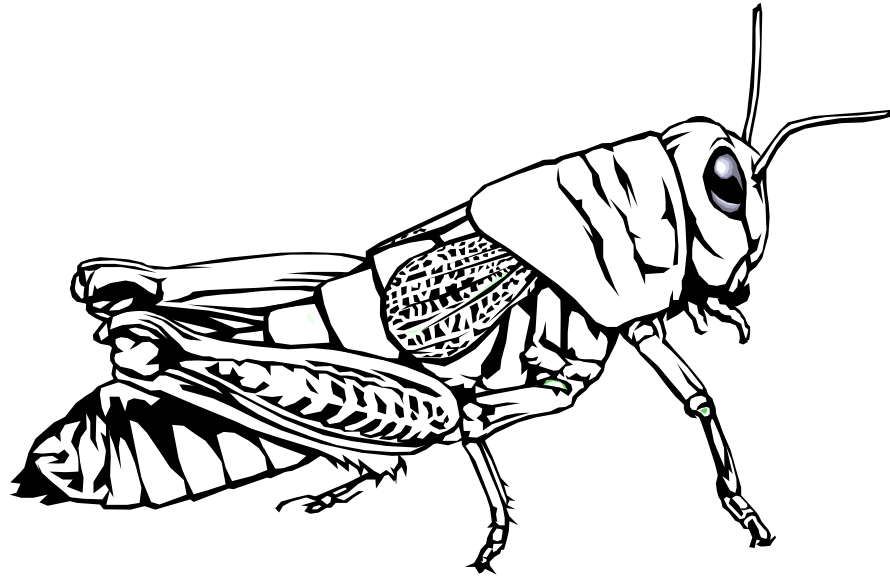
The bat will not sleep at night.



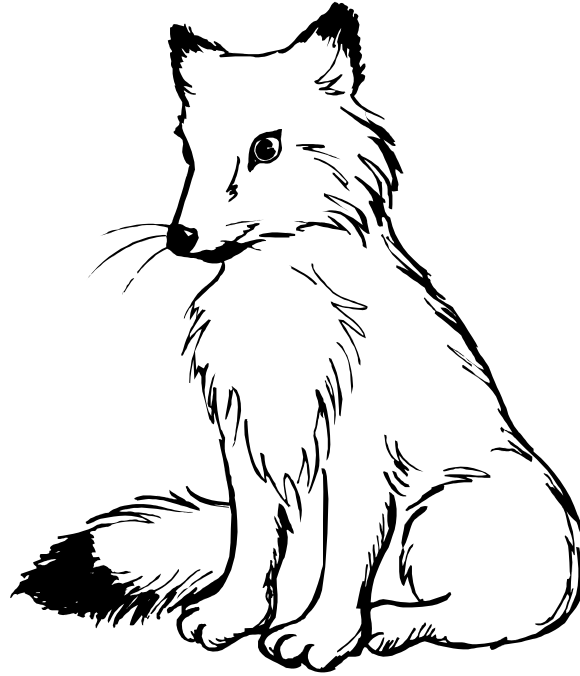
The raccoon will not sleep at night.



The firefly will not sleep at night.



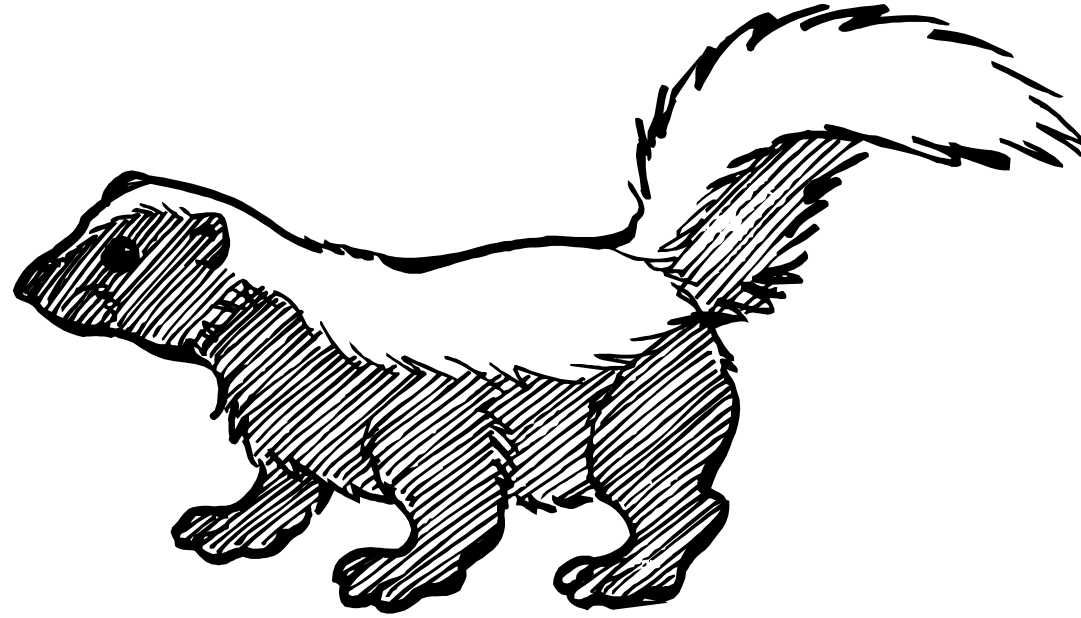
The cricket will not sleep at night.
