## Scripture Cut-Apart Easter Eggs

Preparation: There are 7 Scriptures to be cut apart. You will need 7 different colors of eggs, one color per verse. After cutting out one verse at a time (so as not to get the words mixed up), place each section of the verse inside of an egg, making sure to use the same color of egg for all of the sections of that verse. The first six verses require 6 eggs, the last verse requires 8 eggs.

John 3:16	"For God	so loved the world
that he gave his one and only Son,	that whoever believes in him	shall not perish but have eternal life.
John 11:25	Jesus said to her,	"I am the resurrection
and the life.	He who believes in me will live,	even though he dies.
Matthew 28:6	He is not here;	he has risen,
just as he said.	Come and see	the place where he lay.

1 Peter 2:24	He himself bore our sins	in his body on the tree,
so that we might die to sins	and live for righteousness;	by his wounds you have been healed.

Isaiah 53:5	But he was pierced for our transgressions,	he was crushed for our iniquities;
the punishment	that brought us peace was upon him,	and by his wounds we are healed.

Romans 5:8	But God	demonstrates his own love for us
in this:	While we were still sinners,	Christ died for us.

1 Corinthians 15:3-4	For what I received I passed on to you	as of first importance:
that Christ died for our sins	according to the Scriptures,	that he was buried,
that he was raised on the third day	according to the Scriptures
